## SOCIAL DISTANCING OPTIONS FOR THE BEAUTY INDUSTRY

Social Distancing is proven to slow the spread of viruses in a community. However, the beauty industry is very much a hands-on one. Here are some considerations at this time to help with social distancing.

- Decide how you will stagger your appointments (e.g. if you normally had 10 appointments now you may cut down to half the amount).
- For those persons categorized as vulnerable they can have individual house calls made to them for beauty services as long as they are not ill e.g. waxing, nails.
- Discourage walk-ins.
- Discourage patrons from bringing along friends to their appointments.
- Space appointments with enough lag time between clients.
- Sanitize the salon, space and equipment thoroughly between client appointments.
- Change and sanitize aprons between appointments.
- Where practicable, face shields can be used to minimize any microscopic liquid particles from entering through the face and reduce you from touching your face (face shields similar to that which dentists would wear covering from the forehead to chin).
- Advise all clients if they are ill to reschedule their appointment.
- Salons with 2 or more stylists/ techs should coordinate who will be in and when to ensure social distancing.
- Use all personal protective equipment to protect yourself.
